The Information and Privacy Commissioner releases her comments about the new identification requirements under the *Elections Act*

WHITEHORSE – As a result of recent amendments to the *Elections Act*, the Chief Electoral Officer is required by that Act to consult a number of persons, including Yukon's Information and Privacy Commissioner, before making her decision about the kinds of identification that electors should be able to use for the purposes of the *Elections Act*.
